than any child ever should. When they were merely toddlers, their mother abandoned them and the rest of the family.

Although their father loved them very much, his battle with alcoholism proved to be too much for him to overcome. He struggled with short-lived attempts at sobriety and his inability to keep a job. Sadly, the boys suffered the harsh consequences of this cruel pattern. During those years of neglect, they developed medical problems that went undiagnosed and unattended, and to this day, they live with the adverse effects of those problems.

By the grace of God, their father decided to give them a better chance of becoming successful, happy children and brought them to the mission.
